The Oregon Community Food Systems Network (OCFSN) is a collaborative of 40 nonprofit organizations and allies dedicated to strengthening local and regional food systems to deliver better economic, social, health and environmental outcomes across the state.

The OCFSN Convening is a two-day, invitation-only event that brings a select group of community leaders together to network, share information, participate in workshops and trainings, and advance common goals for positive food systems change. The 2017 OCFSN Convening will be held April 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> at the Oregon Garden in Silverton, and is expected to draw an audience of 80-100 non-profit, business, and agency leaders.

### **Additional Information on OCFSN**



OCFSN envisions an environmentally and economically resilient food system for Oregon, with meaningful access to healthy and affordable foods that are grown and processed regionally, and entrepreneurial opportunity and fulfilling livelihoods for employees throughout the supply chain.

OCFSN brings people and organizations together to change the food system, starting with a common understanding of issues and shared goals. A set of shared food systems indicators have also been developed, with data available for all 36 Oregon counties posted at [OCFSN.net](http://OCFSN.net).

OCFSN also supports collaborative work groups focused on four initial priority areas including:

- **SNAP Match:** Doubling the purchasing power of SNAP dollars spent on local produce in Oregon farmers' markets and rural grocery stores.
- **Veggie Rx:** Partnering with health care providers to improve health outcomes by increasing consumption of fresh local foods.
- **Access to Land:** Supporting planned land transitions and solutions to access to land and capital challenges for beginning farmers.
- **Wholesale Market Development:** Business and value-chain development to maximize sales of local foods to retail and institutional markets.
